


## Heritage Lottery Fund Project

On Friday June 23rd an art exhibition will be held at St Peter's Church on St Peter's Street to celebrate the history of some of Derby's lesser known streets.

The streets highlighted in green are part of a multi-million pound Heritage Lottery Fund / Derby City Council regeneration scheme, and participants from Derby Adult Learning Service and Derby College have been invited to collaborate in the project.

They have been challenged to use archive material to artistically interpret these historic streets through textiles, pottery, ceramics, paintings, photography, drama and graphic design.

Their work will be on display at the gallery launch in St Peter's Church on 23 June from 6pm onwards. Members of the public are welcome to join us in celebrating the history of some of Derby's oldest streets.


