### **Is your child missing out?**

Your child may be entitled to Pupil Premium funding. This is **additional money** the government gives to schools to help disadvantaged children get extra help and support.

At Hardwick every child who receives Pupil Premium funding is entitled to:

- **Free** breakfast club every day
- **Free** school meals every day (for those registered for Free School Meals)
- **Free** school visits for the year
- **Free** school sweatshirt and PE kit every year
- **Free** residential visit to Kingswood in Year 5 or Year 6
- **Free** music instruments and music lessons in Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6
- **Extra teaching support and tuition throughout the year**

Your child may be entitled to receive Pupil Premium funding if your child is adopted or you are receiving:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income less than £16 000
- Support under the Immigration and Asylum Act
- Universal Credit

If you think you might be entitled to Pupil Premium funding please fill in the attached form and send it back to school with your child or hand it in at the school office.
