If your child suffers from travel sickness please tell a member of staff and make sure they take any medication before coming to school or wear travel wrist bands. If they need to take one for the return journey, then please place one in an envelope with your

child's name clearly written on the front and pass it to a member of staff upon arrival. You will be asked to sign a consent form.

Please pack them a spare set of clothes just in case!!

If your child is asthmatic and uses an inhaler would you please ensure Mrs Maciejewska has your child's inhaler in school.

Due to the changing weather in March, it is important that the children are dressed appropriately for the visit. Please ensure your child wears suitable walking shoes for the outdoors including a waterproof jacket in case of rain. If it is a sunny day please ensure your child is wearing a sun hat and sun screen.

In order for this visit to go ahead a voluntary contribution of £14.26 per child is required, unless your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding. You can pay in instalments over the next few months if you so wish.

Please log into ParentPay to make your payment in full or in installments **before Friday 24th February 2023**. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium, please also log in to ParentPay to give your consent for them to go on the trip.
