

Year 1: What do I need to do?

Year 1 children might be able to come back to school from

Wednesday 3rd June

We will phone you to tell you if we are open and if your child has a place.

Year 1 children need to come to school at

8:45am



When you arrive, come in through the small key stage 1 gate on St James Road. Drop your child off at the Year 1 cloakroom doors.

Parents need to walk around the side of the building and exit through the big KS2 gates onto Hastings Street.



Only 1 parent should bring children to school and collect at the end of the day. Parents should try not to gather around school. Try not to bring children who are not attending school.

Parents must not enter the school building.



Year 1 children need to be collected between 2:00pm and 2:15pm



Home Time



Parents need to wait for children on the playground outside Year 1.

Enter through the small KS1 gate on St James Road and exit through the big KS2 gate on Hastings Street.



Do not bring any bags or belongings into school from home.

Children will be given everything they need in school.



Children can wear PE kit with trainers or comfy shoes and a school jumper or cardigan to school. This is so they don't need to get changed. Children should change their clothes when they get home and wear clean clothes to school the next day.



Do not come into school if you have a cough, high temperature or lose your sense of smell or taste. You still need to self-isolate if this happens.

If your child shows symptoms in school, you will be called to collect them.



Try not to go to the school office. Ring school if you need to speak to someone.
