Staff are responsible for familiarising themselves with the school's policies, and for following the procedures contained within them.

Risk assessment's help school staff understand what the potential hazards to health and safety may be of different activities.

These hazards include activities and resources in and out of school.

The risk assessment helps school plan activities to ensure that they are safe and that any risks are minimised.



School has multiple risk assessments for many situations, for example experiments in a science lesson, using tools in DT, or going on a school trip
