Dear Parents/Guardians

On Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June we will be taking Year 3 pupils on a trip to Dovedale.

The aim of this trip is for pupils to gain some first-hand experience of visiting the countryside and to observe its natural and man-made features. It will also give the children first-hand experience of viewing rivers relating to their new topic.

The cost of this visit will be **£6.20** per person to cover transportation costs.

The coach will be departing school at approximately **9.15 am** and returning at approximately **3.00 pm**.

**Your child will need to bring a packed lunch in a suitable bag. Please do not send fizzy drinks or drinks in glass bottles for safety reasons. A school packed lunch will be provided for those pupils who are entitled to free school meals.**

Children should come to school wearing their school uniform as usual and wear suitable walking shoes for the outdoors including a waterproof jacket in case of rain. If it is a hot day, please provide a sun hat and sun cream.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, then please ensure that they take a travel sickness pill before coming to school. If they need to take one for the return journey, then please place one in an envelope with your child's name clearly written on the front and pass it to a member of staff upon arrival. You will be asked to sign a consent form.

Please log into ParentPay to give your consent and make your payment of £6.20 before Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium, please also log in to ParentPay to give your consent for them to go on the trip.
