

Reception: What do I need to do?

Reception children might be able to come back to school from

Monday 8th June

We will phone you to tell you if we are open and if your child has a place.

Reception children need to
come to school at
9:15am



When you arrive, come in
through the main
entrance, go past Nursery
and around to the gate to
the Reception outdoor area
as normal.



Only 1 parent should bring children to school and collect at the end of the day. Parents should try not to gather around school. Try not to bring children who are not attending school.

Parents must not enter the school building.



When you leave, you need to go through the Nursery outdoor area and through the car park gate.



Reception children need to be collected between **2:00pm and 2:15pm** from the outdoor Reception gate.

Use the same route in and out.



Home Time



Do not bring anything into school from home.



Children can wear PE kit with trainers or comfy shoes and a school jumper or cardigan to school. This is so they don't need to get changed. Children should change their clothes when they get home and wear clean clothes to school the next day.



Do not come into school if you have a cough, high temperature or lose your sense of smell or taste. You still need to self-isolate if this happens.

If your child shows symptoms while in school, you will be asked to collect them.



Try not to go to the school office. Ring school if you need to speak to someone.



Children are not allowed to wear masks in school.
