

Nursery: What do I need to do?

Nursery children might be able to come back to school from

Wednesday 3rd June

We will phone you to tell you if we are open and if your child has a place.

Nursery children need to come to school at

8:45am



When you arrive, don't use the normal Nursery door. Come in through the main entrance, go past Nursery and around to the gate to the Nursery outdoor area. Children will go in through the big Nursery doors.



Only 1 parent should bring children to school and collect at the end of the day. Parents should try not to gather around school. Try not to bring children who are not attending school.

Parents must not enter the Nursery classroom.



When you leave, you need to go through the Nursery outdoor area and through the car park gate.



Nursery children need to be collected between
11:30am and 11:45am
from the big Nursery doors.

Use the same route in and out.



Home Time



Please bring a spare pair of clothes and nappies if needed into school on the first day. These will stay in school.



Do not bring anything else from home into school.



Children can wear PE kit with trainers or comfy shoes and a school jumper or cardigan to school. This is so they don't need to get changed. Children should change their clothes when they get home and wear clean clothes to school the next day.

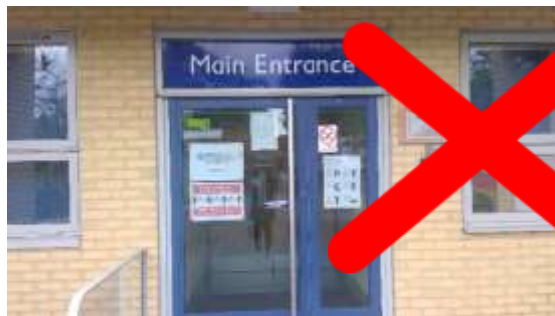


Do not come into school if you have a cough, high temperature or lose your sense of smell or taste. You still need to self-isolate if this happens.

If your child is poorly while in school, you will be called to collect them.



Try not to go to the school office. Ring school if you need to speak to someone.



Children are not allowed to wear masks in school.
